# KNOW YOUR RIGHTS INSIDE YOUR HOME When Police Demand Entry or Action from Outside

Your home is protected by the U.S. Constitution. Police need a warrant or urgent need (e.g., danger) to enter or act (Payton v. New York, 1980). Ask police to show their badge and provide name/badge number.

### **No Warrant? No Entry (Fourth Amendment Search or Seizure)**

- 1. Ask: "Do you have a warrant?" "The right of the people to be secure in their houses against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated"
- 2. If no warrant, say: "I do not consent to entry or searches without a warrant."

#### **Emergency Claims (Fourth Amendment Search or Seizure)**

- 1. Ask: "Whats the emergency? Give details." Video record if legal and safe (First Amendment right, check state laws). "The right of the people to be secure in their houses against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated"
- 2. If unclear, say: "I do not consent without a warrant or clear reason." (Brigham City v. Stuart, 2006)

#### **Ordered to Exit (Fourth Amendment Seizure)**

- 1. Ask: "Am I under arrest or detained?" "The right of the people to be secure in their houses against unreasonable searches and seizures, shall not be violated"
- 2. If no arrest, say: "I stay in my home without legal reason. Im not required to provide ID unless detained." Video record if legal and safe (First Amendment right, check state laws). (United States v. Mendenhall, 1980)

## Wellness Checks (First Amendment Free Speech; Fourth Amendment Search or Seizure)

### Stay Silent (Fifth Amendment Self-Incrimination; Sixth Amendment Right to Counsel)

- 1. Say: "I invoke my Fifth Amendment right to remain silent." "No person shall be compelled in any criminal case to be a witness against himself"
- 2. Say: "I want an attorney before speaking." "In all criminal prosecutions, the accused shall enjoy the right to have the Assistance of Counsel for his defence." (Miranda v. Arizona, 1966)
